Warm Greetings

The month of April brings us even longer days, warmer temperatures, and the return of residents and birds that have spent the winter in warmer climates. The next meeting of the Town Board is scheduled for Monday, April 14th at 7:00 p.m. Some of the items that will be covered at this meeting include: zoning officer's report, town clerk's report, supervisor's report, committee reports, a public hearing on Mass Gathering Permit #1 for a regatta on May 10th and 11th by the Saratoga Lake Rowing Assoc., a public hearing on local law #3 amending the zoning ordinance permitting wind energy turbines, and opening of bids for the sale of a 1987 Gradall. On Thursday, April 10th the Town Board will conduct their monthly agenda meeting at which they will review agenda items scheduled for the April 14th meeting and hear presentations by Dotti Kozersky on the Over the Rainbow Program and from Diane Metz of Saratoga PLAN on the Fish Creek Trail.

Corner School Proposed New Town Hall

The town board unanimously voted to recommend the corner school as the best option for a new town hall. Informational brochures were recently mailed to all registered voters of the town. Open houses are scheduled for April 11th and 15th from 5:00 to 7:00 pm and on April 26th from 9:00 to 12:00 noon. A referendum vote for the residents is scheduled for Tuesday April 29th from 12:00 noon to 8:00 pm. Voters in districts 1 & 2 will vote in the basement of the town hall, voters in districts 3 & 5 will vote in the Quaker Springs Fire House, and voters in district 4 will vote in the Victory Community Center. All legal residents of the town 18 years of age and older are qualified to vote.
