News From the Assessor's Office

Town Assessor Victoria Hayner reports that the town equalization rate will be 64%. Grievance Day was held on May 26, 2009. A few property owners appeared before the board to grieve their assessment. The Board will make its determinations and notify them of their assessment by June 15th. The Final Assessment Roll for 2009 will be available on July 1st in the Town Hall. This roll will be used for taxation purposes for 2009-2010 school taxes and 2010 County and Town taxes. Anyone with questions regarding their assessment may contact the Assessor. The Assessor's Office is open Monday – Thursday from 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM. The Assessor is in the office on Monday and Thursday or by appointment.
