Surrender Week is sponsored by a number of organizations including the Fort Hardy Committee. The American victory at Saratoga is recognized as the turning point of the American Revolution. DON'T LOSE YOUR STAR EXEMPTION! If you are receiving the BASIC Star exemption and have not registered with New York State Department of Tax and Finance, do so today. If you receive a Senior Enhanced STAR exemption, you do not need to register with NYS Dept of Tax and Finance. If you have misplaced your letter from NYS with your registration code, you may look it up online or contact my office and we will help you. If you have questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact our office at 695-3644, ext. 312. Our office is located at 12 Spring Street on the 2nd floor.
