Town Receives Salt Storage Shed Grant

The Town of Saratoga has been notified that they have received a \$100,000. State and Municipal Facilities Program Grant. We are grateful to Senator Kathy Marchione for her assistance in being awarded this grant. The purpose of the grant is to construct a large salt storage building that will store salt for the Town of Saratoga and the Villages of Schuylerville and Victory. The large capacity of this building will insure that the municipalities will not run out of salt during long duration storms and will improve the environment by preventing any salt water run-off. The building should be built this summer and fall at the highway garage facility on Route 32.

Assessor's News -
